

IQAC Report 2020-21

Due to the lockdown announced by the government against the backdrop of Covid-19, the entire educational process in the academic year 2020-21 was implemented online by government order. Accordingly, the meetings organised under the IQAC department of the college were held sometimes online and sometimes offline as per the current situation. Also, various activities implemented under IQAC were carried out online using various social media.

On 02/09/2020 from 3:00 to 4:30 pm AQAR members, professors were discussed regarding NAAC as well as ImAQAR. After discussing whether the AQAR 2019-20 should be done as per the new form or given in the previous form, S.S.R. AQAR also decided to submit in a new form as it was to be submitted in a new form.

On 05/10/2020 At the meeting held at 3:15 pm under the chairmanship of Prachar, the criteria for preparation of IQAC should be prepared daily by the college from 2:30 to 3:30 member professors to prepare the criteria documents.

On 06/10/2020, the college professor Dr. Rohini Tadas, Dr. Archana Watkar, Dr. Sandhya Samudra and coordinator Dr. Criteria no. 1 Issue wise discussed and made a list of required documents.

At a meeting held on 15 December 2020 at 1:00 pm, it was decided that IQAC related expert guides should be called for guidance on SSS and SSR regarding NAAC. Relevant guidance will be taken online. Also regarding SSS, the concerned professor Dr. Watkar discusses the need for students to fill out questionnaires at the primary level and to involve alumni of the Y.C.M Open University.

Ongoing work on NAAC and IQAR was reviewed on 28/12/2020 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Principal. At this time, Dr. Forms 04 and 05 were submitted by Dr. Rohini Tadas. Form - 02 while Dr. Watkar. Dharaskar reviewed the work done regarding Form-03. He also said that the required documents are being collected and about 50% of the work is being completed.




